July 13 -- Lake Lot Owners Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Kathy Welch at 6:45.

The primary issue of discussion was Bellevue City's removal of the algae protection system.

The board purchased an algae protection system and installed it in the wetlands beyond the dam in Zweibel Creek.

It was successfully holding back algae while allowing unobstructed water flow.

A complaint to the City of Bellevue prompted the Corps of engineers to request a removal of the system on July 30.

However, the city of Bellevue was removing it earlier in July. Fortunately the board was able to gain possession of the system before it was taken by the city.

A confusing chain of events then occurred:

Mark Wray of the Corps of Engineers indicated that a permit was required for installation.

Bellevue wanted us to sign a waiver for removal of the system after it had been removed.

Since the Corps of Engineers are primarily concerned with navigable waters, there were questions about their concerns.

Amanda Grant (Natural Resources Department) could not shed light upon why the Corps was involved.

While the complaint said that the wetlands were changed by the presence of the system, the biologist from the Wetland management department indicated that it was causing no harm.

Solutions:

The board will consult our lawyer before signing any waiver.

Motion: Steve Hermansky will talk to Mr. Wray about our predicament and follow up with the board.

Motion: Kathy Welch 2nd: Terry Franks Unanimous vote.
